

Enrollment/School Assignment

Students who reside within Coquillard's boundaries will be assigned to attend Coquillard based on address. South Bend Schools has 17 elementary schools, including seven magnet options: Kennedy Academy, Nuner Fine Arts Academy, Marquette Montessori Academy, Madison STEAM Academy, McKinley's Dual Language Immersion Program, Hamilton Traditional School, and Swanson Traditional School. There are six middle schools, including four magnet options: Dickinson Fine Arts Academy, Jefferson Traditional School, LaSalle Academy, and Jackson's Project Lead the Way. There is one K-8 magnet school, Clay International Academy. Students throughout the corporation may apply for admission to the magnet schools. Students are admitted based on capacity and racial compliance.
